MEETING DATE, TIME & PLACE: Aug. 6, 10 @ 12:00 p.m. @ First Baptist Church.

Registration begins at 12:00. We will not be able to wait for anyone who arrives after 12:30. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The only meal that is not included in the initial cost is dinner at Lagoon. Please set aside money for this meal. Every year we have a youth that does not set aside enough spending money for this meal. Any parent who is concerned that their student would not set this money aside on their own, can put the cash in a sealed envelope with their student's name on the front. No checks please. The envelope needs to be given directly to Dave or Toni by the parent so no confusion occurs.

RULES OF CONDUCT:

Students and sponsors are urged to exercise discretion and modesty regarding the selection of clothing they wear. Christians can hurt their testimony, cause another to stumble in their Christian walk and possibly offend others by the clothing they wear. Though the clothing may not intentionally be worn to be offensive, nonetheless, often times it is. With this in mind, the following dress code and conduct code will be enforced.

Ladies

- No halter-tops, spaghetti straps, or bare-midriff clothing (belly button or belly rings showing).
- No mini dresses or skirts.
- Shorts must be mid-length. No short shorts, split-sided jogging shorts, or spandex style shorts.
- Swimwear must be a modest one-piece. Absolutely no 2-piece suits are allowed unless a shirt is worn over it at all times. The shirt must cover the belly button. Anyone who doesn't follow this guideline will not be allowed to swim.

Guys

- Shorts must follow the same guidelines as the girls.
- A shirt must be worn at all times unless swimming. No exceptions.
- Baggy pants may be worn with a belt.
- Race swimwear. (Speedo, tank suits) are not allowed. Anyone who does not follow this guideline will not be allowed to swim.

What to bring?

- Bible, pen, paper, clothing, towel if swimming at Lagoon, sun block, personal hygiene products, money for dinner at Lagoon, spending money (optional), snacks (optional), and a good attitude. You can bring your cell phone but must have it off during conference times. If your parents need to reach you during those times they can contact Dave at 208-431-8691. Any electronic item being used during conference times may result in that item being taken and returned at the end of the trip. The church or any adult will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items.

What not to bring?

- Secular (non-Christian) music
- Electronic equipment including hand held games
- Drugs, alcohol, or cigarettes will not be allowed.
- Fire arms, weapons or fire works
- Bad language
- Bad attitudes

Rules:

- Girls are not allowed in any male rooms or males in any girl rooms without an adult sponsor with them.
- Students from other churches are not allowed in our rooms and our students are not allowed to be in other church's rooms.
- Students will be expected to show respect and follow directions from all leaders and adults.
- There is a six-inch rule for male and female students. This includes holding hands.
- No fighting.
